Health Requirements:

- (A) Llamas moved within Ohio for exhibition when presented for exhibition must show no evidence of contagious or infectious disease.
- (B) Llamas imported into Ohio for exhibition must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within thirty (30) days and must not show any signs of contagious or infectious disease at exhibition.

Registration Requirements:

All llamas five months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes and Non-Breeder, must be registered with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corp. (CLRC). **Copies of registration papers must accompany entry.**

Youth Ages: Junior 8-10; Intermediate 11-13; Senior 14 – 18 as of January 1st, except those that have their eighth birthday during the year. They are eligible to show as of that day. Because of ILR-SD division of youth, please note that the Intermediate Class and Senior Class are also labeled *Novice* and *Advanced*. Youth 12-18 showing under ILR-SD must pick the correct class based upon ILR-SD youth class description.

Awards: Premiums and Ribbons to 4th place.

ALSA/ILR-SD/Both: Exhibitors need to indicate on the entry form which show they are entering. Exhibitors can enter both shows if they desire. Fees for each show are marked on the entry form.

Get-of-Sire and Produce of Dam classes: You may count these classes as your 'second' entry for your llamas, even though you are entering the Dam or Sire. Please be sure to fill out a separate box for this entry listing the information about the Sire or Dam and also which animals will actually be shown. Remember to include the appropriate animal fee (ALSA-\$5; ILR-SD-\$2) for your Dam and/or Sire on the entry form.

Youth Exhibitors: Youth cannot enter the same animal in both the youth classes and open classes. They must take a different animal through the open classes.

Stalling Requirements: All exhibitors **must pay for a stall**. Straw or hay bedding is NOT permitted at the Eden Park facility.

Camping: Camping is available at the Eden Park facility for \$30. You may enclose the camping fee with your check or pay Eden Park when you arrive.

PLEASE! Read through the entry form carefully before completing it. If you are entering the ALSA show, you must send a copy of your ALSA membership card (or pay the non-member fee) and \$5 per animal entered. If you are entering the ILR-SD show, you will pay the \$2 fee per animal. Consequently, if you are entering both shows, you will need to send a copy of your ALSA membership card and pay \$7 per animal.
