**Health Requirements:**

- (A) Llamas moved within Ohio for exhibition when presented for exhibition must show no evidence of contagious or infectious disease.
- (B) Llamas imported into Ohio for exhibition must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within thirty (30) days and must not show any signs of contagious or infectious disease at exhibition.

**Registration Requirements:**

All llamas five months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes and Non-Breeder, must be registered with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corp. (CLRC). **Copies of registration papers must accompany entry.** In ILR-SD non-registered animals can be shown in performance, showmanship and youth after they have obtained a tracking number from the ILR office.

Membership in the ILR-SD is NOT required to show in the ILR-SD show.

**Youth Ages:** For the ALSA show, the ages will be Junior 8-10; Intermediate 11-13; Senior 14 – 18 as of January 1<sup>st</sup>, except those that have their eighth birthday during the year. They are eligible to show as of that day. In the ILR-SD show, Junior Youth ages are 7 – 11. Please note that the Intermediate Class and Senior Class are also labeled *Novice* and *Advanced*. Youth 12-18 showing under ILR-SD must pick the correct class based upon ILR-SD youth class description, i.e. the number of years of showing experience (Intermediate/Novice is ages 12-18 with less than 3 years showing experience and Senior/Advanced is ages 12-18 with 3 years or more showing experience) Youth classes entered might vary from ALSA to ILR-SD.

**Awards:** Premiums and Ribbons to 4<sup>th</sup> place. (Both ALSA & ILR-SD Shows)  
Grand & Reserve Champions (Both ALSA & ILR-SD Shows)  
High Point Open Performance Llama Overall (will include Adult showmanship)  
High Point Senior/Advanced Youth Overall  
High Point Intermediate/Novice Youth Overall  
High Point Junior Youth Overall  
Best-of-Show Male  
Best-of-Show Female

**ALSA/ILR-SD/Both: Exhibitors need to indicate on the entry form which show they are entering. Exhibitors can enter both shows if they desire. Fees for each show are marked on the entry form.**

**Get-of-Sire and Produce of Dam classes:** You may count these classes as your 'second' entry for your llamas, even though you are entering the Dam or Sire. Please be sure to fill out a separate box for this entry listing the information about the Sire or Dam and also which animals will actually be shown. Remember to include the appropriate animal fee (ALSA-\$5; ILR-SD-\$4) for your Dam and/or Sire on the entry form.

**Youth Exhibitors:** Youth cannot enter the same animal in both the youth classes and open classes. They must take a different animal through the open classes.

**Chinese Raffle/Silent Auction:** ORVLA will be sponsoring a Chinese Raffle & Silent Auction during this show. Please bring an item with you for this raffle. Questions? Contact Lisa Blidar (330-929-8879).

**Stalling Requirements:** All stalls will be pre-assigned. You are also free to work out of your trailer.

**Show Sponsors:** ORVLA invites farms and/or businesses to be sponsors for this show.

**PLEASE! Read through the entry form carefully before completing it.** If you are entering the ALSA show, you must send a copy of your ALSA membership card (or pay the non-member fee) and \$5 per animal entered. All ALSA show classes are numbered with an 'A.' If you are entering the ILR-SD show, you will pay the \$4 fee per animal. You do not need to be a member of the ILR-SD or ILR to show in the ILR-SD classes nor is there a non-membership fee. All ILR-SD classes are labeled with a 'B.' Consequently, if you are entering both shows, you will need to send a copy of your ALSA membership card and pay \$9 per animal. You would enter both the 'A' class and the 'B' class for your llama. Classes may be combined if entries are low.
