The International Camelid Institute (ICI) is pleased to announce that it has added several new videos for camelid owners and breeders that are available

FREE on its website, www.icinfo.org Current titles include: “Assessing Your Animal Prior to Calling Your Vet” (available in English and Spanish), “Proper Halter Fit for Camelids”, “How to Give Injections”, “Removal of Fighting Teeth” and “How to Pass a Somach Tube”. Also new is the addition of the “Barn Book”. These are downloadable PDFs, that highlight important points from the videos, which owners can print and keep in the barn for those “need that information now!” situations - when reviewing a whole video is impractical. These will be updated regularly.

Production of the videos is under the supervision of camelid veterinarians but several of the videos have been done by an alpaca or llama owner in the hope that owners will feel more comfortable taking on many of these tasks that are necessary for proper herd health and maintenance. It is also be noted when it is appropriate to contact a veterinarian.

The videos have been well received and viewed by owners and veterinarians in the United States, Australia, Peru, Chile, Great Britain, France and The United Arab Emirates.
